Putting less in the sky

Greenhouse gases (GHGs) like CO₂ trap heat in the atmosphere and contribute to global warming. Because electricity, transportation and manufacturing are some of the biggest contributors of CO₂, we continue to drive reductions in GHGs at our facilities.



276,000 metric tons

Since 2006, we have reduced the total amount of GHGs generated by our operations by nearly 276,000 metric tons.



25 more facilities using LEDs

In 2015, more than 25 of our facilities converted to LED lighting, eliminating our annual GHG emissions by more than 2,600 metric tons.



This is the equivalent of **384 family homes' electricity use for one year.**



This is the equivalent of

58,300 passenger cars removed from the road for one year.

Adding less to the ground

Methane, a GHG associated with landfills, is twenty times more potent than CO₂. So reducing our waste has significant impact. It also conserves valuable resources and keeps the communities we serve cleaner.



12,572 tons

Since 2010, Eaton has reduced waste sent to landfill by 42%, a reduction of 12,572 tons.



This is the equivalent of more than 1,000 full garbage trucks.




93 facilities

During 2016, 23 Eaton facilities achieved zero waste-to-landfill status. To date, 93 Eaton locations are zero waste-to-landfill, including 83 manufacturing sites.

Taking less from the water

As global demand for water grows, all of us need to be more careful with its use. While Eaton does not consume large amounts of water, the water we do use is critical to our operations—and vital to the communities in which we operate.



Since 2010, we reduced our water consumption by 22.5%, or 1.07 million cubic meters.



This is the equivalent of 428 filled Olympic-sized swimming pools.



64 million gallons saved

Our facility in Horseheads, N.Y., was one of our biggest water users. In 2014, we installed a closed-loop water system to re-use water required for manufacturing, helping reduce annual usage from 114 million to 50 million gallons.
